



Mandate

The Bureau of Quarantine (BQ) under the Department of Health (DOH), with the category of a first-class line bureau, shall have a nationwide scope of function and international commitment in accord with the International Health Regulations (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO).

The Bureau is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations (enforcement, detection or surveillance) as necessary to prevent the introduction, transmission or spread of public health emergencies of international concern (PHEIC) from foreign countries into the Philippines.

Jurisdiction and Functions of the Bureau

The examination of ports of entry and exit in the Philippines of incoming and outgoing vessels and aircraft.

The necessary surveillance over their sanitary conditions, as well as over their cargoes, passengers, crews, and all personal effects, and

The issuance of quarantine certificates, bills of health, or other equivalent documents shall be issued in and be conducted by the Bureau.

This Bureau shall have authority over incoming and outgoing vessels, both domestic and foreign, including those of the same and over their wharves and anchorages, and over inland and airports, insofar as it is necessary for the proper enforcement of the provisions of this Act.


