



Mandate

The Bureau of Quarantine (BQ) under the Department of Health (DOH), with the category of a first-class line bureau, shall have a nationwide scope of action and international commitment in accord with the International Health Regulations (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO).

The Bureau is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations (prevention, detention or surveillance) as necessary to prevent the introduction, transmission or spread of "public health emergencies of international concern" (PHEIC) from foreign countries into the Philippines.

Jurisdiction and Functions of the Bureau

The examination at ports of entry and exit in the Philippines of incoming and outgoing vessels and aircraft.

The necessary surveillance over air sanitary conditions, as well as over their cargoes, passengers, crews, and all personal effects, and

The issuance of quarantine certificates, bills of health, or their equivalent documents shall be visited in and be conducted by the Bureau.

The Bureau shall have authority over incoming and outgoing vessels both domestic and foreign, including those of the navy and navy, their wharves and anchorage, and over aircraft and airports, insofar as it is necessary for the proper enforcement of the provisions of its Act.
