Mandate

The Bureau of Quarantine (BoQ) under the Department of Health (DOH), with the category of a first-class line bureau, shall have a nationwide scope of function and international commitment in accord with the International Health Regulations (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO).

The Bureau is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations (apprehension, detention or surveillance) as necessary to prevent the introduction, transmission or spread of "public health emergencies of international concern" from foreign countries into the Philippines.

Jurisdiction and

Functions of the Bureau

The examination at ports of entry and exit in the Philippines of incoming and outgoing vessels and aircraft,

The necessary surveillance over their sanitary conditions, as well as over their cargoes, passengers, crews, and all personal effects, and

The issuance of quarantine certificates, bills of health, or other equivalent documents shall be vested in and be conducted by the Bureau.

This Bureau shall have authority over incoming and outgoing vessels both domestic and foreign, including those of the army and navy, their wharfage and anchorage, and over aircraft and airports, insofar as it is necessary for the proper enforcement of the provisions of this Act.

This Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify the issues and concerns raised during the Pre-Bid Conference held on December 03, 2020; 1:00 PM at the PE Conference Room, BOQ, Port Area, Manila.

This Bid Bulletin will form an integral part of the bidding documents for the Procurement of Security Services for Cagayan de Oro, Davao and General Santos BOQ Stations under IB No. PB-2020-03.

2. Clarifications

a. Bid submission

- i. Bids submitted manually shall be in two copies (one original bid and one copy of the original bid) and may also be submitted to the Davao Quarantine Station, Corner Chavez and Magsaysay Sts., Davao City.
- ii. Bid submitted electronically shall be only one copy provided that the same:
 - Uses a two-factor security procedure consisting of an archive format compression and password protection to ensure the security, integrity and confidentiality of the bids submitted;



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- Allows access to a password-protected Bidding Documents on opening date and time. The passwords for accessing the file will be disclosed by the Bidders only during the actual bid opening which may be done in person or face-to-face through videoconferencing, webcasting or similar technology; and
- Capable of generating an audit trail of transactions to ensure the security, integrity and authenticity of bid submissions.

- b. Administrative fee to be followed should be in accordance with latest DOLE guidelines.
- c. Items with amount of zero (0) will be understood as given as free for the government. The words "To be offered for free" must also be indicated.
