Interested buyers shall bid for an entire lot of **Disposal of Unserviceable Equipment** with the floor price amounting to **Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-One Pesos (Php 12,551.00)**. The bid must be submitted to **Ms. Ruth Pacquing**, Member, Disposal Committee Secretariat at the office of the Procurement Section, **not later than June 04, 2021, 09:00 AM** and **opening shall be at 10:00 AM** the same day at the Administrative Division, Office of the Director, Bureau of Quarantine, 25th A.C. Delgado Street, Port Area, Manila

No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by **ten percent (10%)** of the minimum auction bid in the form of cash or cashier's/manager's cheque. Late bids shall not be accepted. Bids will be opened in the presence of all the bidders or their duly designated representatives and COA representative. The highest bidder shall pay the bid bond to the cashier after award. The bid bond of non-winning bidders shall be returned outright.

The Bureau of Quarantine Disposal Committee reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof, waives any formality, requirements, or defects contained therein, and will accept the offer it considers most advantageous to the government.

Mandate

The Bureau of Quarantine (BoQ) under the Department of Health (DOH), with the category of a first-class line bureau, shall have a nationwide scope of function and international commitment in accord with the International Health Regulations (IHR) of the World Health Organization (WHO).

The Bureau is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations (apprehension, detention or surveillance) as necessary to prevent the introduction, transmission or spread of "public health emergencies of international concern" from foreign countries into the Philippines.

Jurisdiction and Functions of the Bureau

The examination at ports of entry and exit in the Philippines of incoming and outgoing vessels and aircraft,

The necessary surveillance over their sanitary conditions, as well as over their cargoes, passengers, crews, and all personal effects, and

The issuance of quarantine certificates, bills of health, or other equivalent documents shall be vested in and be conducted by the Bureau.

This Bureau shall have authority over incoming and outgoing vessels both domestic and foreign, including those of the army and navy, their wharfage and anchorage, and over aircraft and airports, insofar as it is necessary for the proper enforcement of the provisions of this Act.
